Counselor Guidelines

Eligibility for high school student enrollment at Snow College

1. be at least 16 years of age (junior or senior) or 17 years old for the CNA program
2. have permission from parent and home high school to attend college
3. have a cumulative 3.0 GPA or meet the 3.0 standard for the most recently completed semester

In special circumstances, counselors and/or concurrent enrollment advisors may recommend a junior or senior with a GPA of 2.0-2.9 who demonstrates success and high interest in CTE programs. The high school counselor and/or concurrent enrollment advisor must counsel with the student about maturity, effort, and accountability in taking college courses.

A student with a cumulative GPA of less than 2.0 will not be allowed to register for college classes until they have demonstrated substantial academic improvement at their high school.

Student Responsibilities

1. Apply and pay application fee.
2. Receive Badger ID and be admitted.
3. Provide education and career goals and programs of interest.
4. Sign agreement.
5. Submit forms and be recommended by counselor and/or CE advisor. (Parent Forms, Transcript, Steps to Success)
Note: The counselor can collect the forms and send to Christi by email or ask her to stop by and pick them up.
6. Register for classes **before** the first day of class, pay credit and course fees, and buy required course text/materials.

Snow College Academic Standards

Students are expected to perform at a college level by completing assignments and attending classes as outlined by the course instructor. Students should be aware that college classes on average have two hours of homework for every hour in class.

- If a student decides not to complete the college course, it is his/her responsibility to drop the course before the deadline or an F or Unofficial Withdrawal (UW) will appear on the transcript.
- If a student's GPA falls below a 2.0, he/she will be counseled to return to their high school.
- If a student earns an "F" in a Snow College concurrent enrollment course, that student will not be allowed to take any additional concurrent courses from Snow College.

Success = Scholarship Opportunity—Badger Tracks

Students who complete at least 12 credit hours of Snow College Concurrent Enrollment work by the time they graduate from high school with a **3.0 GPA or higher in Snow courses** may benefit from receiving a **\$500 per semester scholarship** (approximately one-third of a semester's tuition). No application is needed for this scholarship to qualify as long as the student meets the requirements and funding is available.
