

Transfer College Partnerships

UVU has partnered with Salt Lake Community College and Snow College to make academic merit scholarships available for incoming transfer students who received meritorious scholarship awards at their previous institution.

These Resident Transfer Academic Merit Scholarships will be selected from students transferring to UVU from SLCC and Snow College who meet the academic criteria, have maintained eligibility for their scholarship at their previous institution, and are pursuing their first bachelor's degree.

Students transferring to UVU who are not eligible for Transfer College Partnership scholarship may still be eligible for a general transfer academic merit scholarship. See Transfer Academic Merit Scholarship drop-down for more information.

Do the following by June 1, 2026, to be automatically considered:

- Complete UVU Admission's Application.
- Provide the Admissions Office with an official copy of your college transcript.
- Share your intention to transfer to UVU with the SLCC or Snow College financial aid office. Continuing eligibility for prior scholarships is shared with UVU's Financial Aid Office.

Even though UVU Academic Merit scholarships do not require a scholarship application, we encourage students to complete the scholarship application to see what other opportunities might be available.

Eligibility

- Complete an Associate's degree at either SLCC or Snow College with a minimum 3.7 cumulative GPA.
